### THE CHURCH PARISH OFFICE

Re-opens for the\_arranging of BAPTISMS/CHRISRENINGS – WEDDINGS and OTHER SERVICES from SATURDAY 11<sup>th</sup> July 9.00am-10.00am and WEDNESDAY 15<sup>th</sup> July 5.30pm-6.30pm - Social distancing, hygiene guidelines apply.

### RESUMPTION OF SUNDAY PUBLIC WORSHIP

Subject to the approval of the Parochial Church Council (PCC) the church will re-open for Holy Communion on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> July 2020 (and successive Sundays after) at the temporary times of :-

09.00am - 9.45am - Holy Eucharist (Said)

09.45am - 10.00am Church to be cleaned and sanitized

10.00am - 10.45am - Holy Eucharist (Said)

10.45am - 11.00am Church to be cleaned and sanitized

11.00am - 11.45am - Holy Eucharist (Said)

11.45am - 12.00pm Church to be cleaned and sanitized

There is a limit of 30 persons for each service

The service will take approximately 30 to 45minutes.

There will be a necessary change of format at these services and social distancing and hygiene requirements will be observed - along with a record of those attending for the required government tracing policy requirements.

12-00pm - 4.00pm - Church open for private prayer and reflection

### SUNDAY CHURCH OPENING TIMES

The Church building will open every Sunday for supervised private prayer from 12.00pmm until 4pm. Social distancing, hygiene and GREEN seating guidelines still apply. (Fr John – usually available 10.15am – 12.00pm)
