

TODAY'S SUNDAY THEME	Our generous God calls us to work in the vineyard. Whether early in the day or late in the afternoon, we are never too late to contribute in the kingdom of heaven.
REFLECTIONS ON TODAY'S READINGS HOLY CROSS	Jonah 3:10-4nd of 4 God provides Jonah with a bush for shade, but then sends a worm to destroy it. Jonah is angry and upset. "If you are concerned about the bush," says God, "is it not right that I should be concerned about Nineveh?" Philippians 1: 21-end Paul urges the Philippians to live in a way that is worthy of the Gospel and to remain strong because God has granted them the privilege of suffering. Matthew 20: 1-16 Jesus tells a parable about a generous vineyard owner. He hires workers at different times of the day, from early morning to just an hour before work ends, and pays them all the same wage. Those who have worked all day complain that it is not fair. The vineyard owner asks them if they are jealous because he is generous.
