# REFLECTIONS FOR EASTER The Resurrection of the Lord

Easter is also called Pascha or Resurrection Sunday, and is the principal festival and holiday celebrating the resurrection of Jesus from the dead, described in the New Testament as having occurred on the third day of his burial after crucifixion. It is the culmination of the Passion of Jesus, preceded by Lent and Holy Week.

In Western Christianity, Eastertide, or the Easter Season, begins on Easter Sunday and lasts seven weeks, ending with the coming of the fiftieth day, Pentecost Sunday – and the gift of the Holy Spirit.

The first Council of Nicaea (325) established two rules, Easter's independence from the Jewish calendar and worldwide uniformity as to the date for its celebration. These were the only rules for Easter explicitly laid down by the council.

Easter is linked to the Jewish Passover by much of its symbolism, as well as by its position in the calendar. In many languages, the words for "Easter" and "Passover" are identical or very similar.

Whilst there is a principal celebration of Easter every year – each passing Sunday is regarded as a celebration of the resurrection of Christ and therefore Easter in itself.

Easter customs vary across the Christian world, and include sunrise services, exclaiming the Paschal greeting, clipping the church, and decorating Easter eggs (symbols of the empty tomb). The Easter lily, a symbol of the resurrection, traditionally decorates the chancel area of churches on this day and for the rest of Eastertide.

# **NEWS TO THE PEWS**

PARISH RE-ORDERING/SPACE SURVEY RESULTS – 2016
PLEASE NOTE! A FULL DETAILED COPY OF THE RESULTS IS
AVAILABLE AT THE BACK OF THE CHURCH – WHAT FOLLOWS
IS A SIMPLE BREAKDOWN.

Following a meeting in July to discuss the church's future in relation to the parish and diocese (VISION 2016), members of the congregation and parish requested that the issue of freeing up space within the church building should be investigated.

The options considered were:

- 1 Removal of pews nearest the wall in the north aisle
- **2** Removal of pews nearest the wall in the north aisle **plus** the pews opposite, up to the line of the pillars
- 3 Removal of all pews

#### **Consultation process and results**

68 forms were returned (14%)

48 forms were returned from members of congregation (71%)

20 forms from members of the parish (29%)

44 forms favoured option 3 (64%) – All pews removed

11 forms favoured option 2 (16%) – Removal of pews nearest the wall in north aisle plus pews opposite

7 forms favoured option 1 (10%) – Removal of pews nearest the wall in the north aisle

- 4 forms were returned in favour of renovating the existing pews (6%)
- 1 form was returned suggesting pews from the back of the church should be removed only (2%)
- 1 form was returned suggesting the front pews should be removed only (2%)

We await an official report on the state of the pews from the diocese.

This is the important annual requirement for Office Holders of the Parish Church. The consent of the person you may wish to nominate **MUST** be obtained first and seconded by another member of the congregation. Please play your part in this important event in the life of our parish. The Easter Vestry (APCM) will be held after the Sunday Service on **30 April**.
